Senior Year Checklist

1. Submit all college applications before October 1st.
2. Review your transcript to make sure that it is accurate then fill out a transcript request
form for each college to which you have applied, and take them to the Guidance Office
3. Complete scholarship applications.
4. Request your FSA ID Number. (See your chart with deadlines for information
on how to do this).
5. Fill out the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) ASAP starting October
1st.
6. Keep in contact with Admissions at colleges to which you have applied to check on the
status of your applications and to check for any missing items.
7. Keep in contact with Financial Aid at colleges to which you have applied to check on
grants and scholarships.
8. Let the counselor know any decisions sent to you by colleges; whether acceptance,
rejection, or waiting list and any scholarship decisions.
9. Confirm and reject acceptances to colleges.
10. Send in required deposits before the deadline.
11. Register with the military after your 18th birthday—boys only.
12. Meet all deadlines.
13. Register to vote after your 18th birthday.
14. Walk with God and pray for wisdom and discernment to make wise choices for now
and for the future.
15. Fill out a final transcript request for the college you plan to attend (by May 1 st). These can be
